

Advice on making representations upon or objections to the proposed Designation Order

Representations

Any person or organisation wishing to make representations concerning the proposed Designation Order can do so online or in writing. This may include support or qualified support for the proposed Glyndŵr National Park.

Objections

Any person or organisation may object to the proposed Designation Order in writing using this paper form or the online version. In order to assist with the processing of representations and objections it is important that objectors clearly give the reason(s) for the objection. Objections to the Order must relate to the criteria used for the designation of National Parks.

The criteria set out in law can be summarised as being:

- an extensive tract of country
- natural beauty
- it offers opportuinities for open-air recreation

Submitting objections, representations and comments

Representations, objections or comments must be duly made and received no later than Monday the 8 December 2025. You can respond to the statutory consultation by:

- Completing and submitting the response form via the project website.
