



The green hatched area will be planting as a mixed woodland. Broadleaf species will include oak, hazel, hornbeam, beech, aspen, rowan, small leaved lime, wych elm walnut, wild cherry, guelder rose and dog rose. The mixture will also include pine species (such as Scots, Macedonian and Weymouth) to provide a food source and habitat for red squirrel.

The Light brown hatched area will be offered for partnership working, in order to meet the objectives set for the site, this is to include community use and the potential for growing food alongside increased tree cover and increased provision for biodiversity.

This area will be co designed and further planting work will be carried out in following planting seasons.
